To the members of the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry,

It is with great sorrow that we inform you of recent passing of Life Fellow, Edward Levinson, BDS, who died on July 14, 2004. Dr. Levinson was a decorated veteran of World War II who began his career as an engineer. After the war, he began studying dentistry, which soon became his passion.

Dr. Levinson was a pioneer in the field of periodontal prosthesis, and opened the first practice of its type in Durban, South Africa in 1963. In addition to his practice in Durban, during 1971 Dr. Levinson opened a practice limited to periodontal prosthesis in London. He continued to work at each practice simultaneously, commuting between the two locations every six weeks.

Dr. Levinson also lectured widely in South Africa, Sweden, England, Israel and the United States. He was the Honorary Professor of Oral Rehabilitation at the University of Pretoria, South Africa, as well as the Co-founder of the International Alpine Dental Conference.

Additionally, Dr Levinson was a member of many national and international groups including The American Academy of Periodontology, British Society of Periodontology, British Society of Restorative Dentistry and the European Academy of Aesthetic Dentistry.

As a highly respected member of the dental community, he will be greatly missed by the Academy, as well as the entire dental profession.

Dr. Levinson was residing in Majorca, Spain at the time of his death. He is survived by his wife Diane, daughters Penny and Janet, son Paul and his stepchildren Tracy, Mark and Lisa. A memorial service will be held in September in London.
